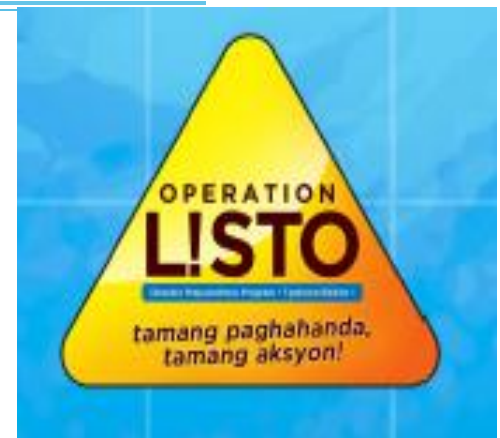

- Advised LGUs to activate pre-disaster monitoring
- Directed LCEs to comply with disaster preparedness protocols

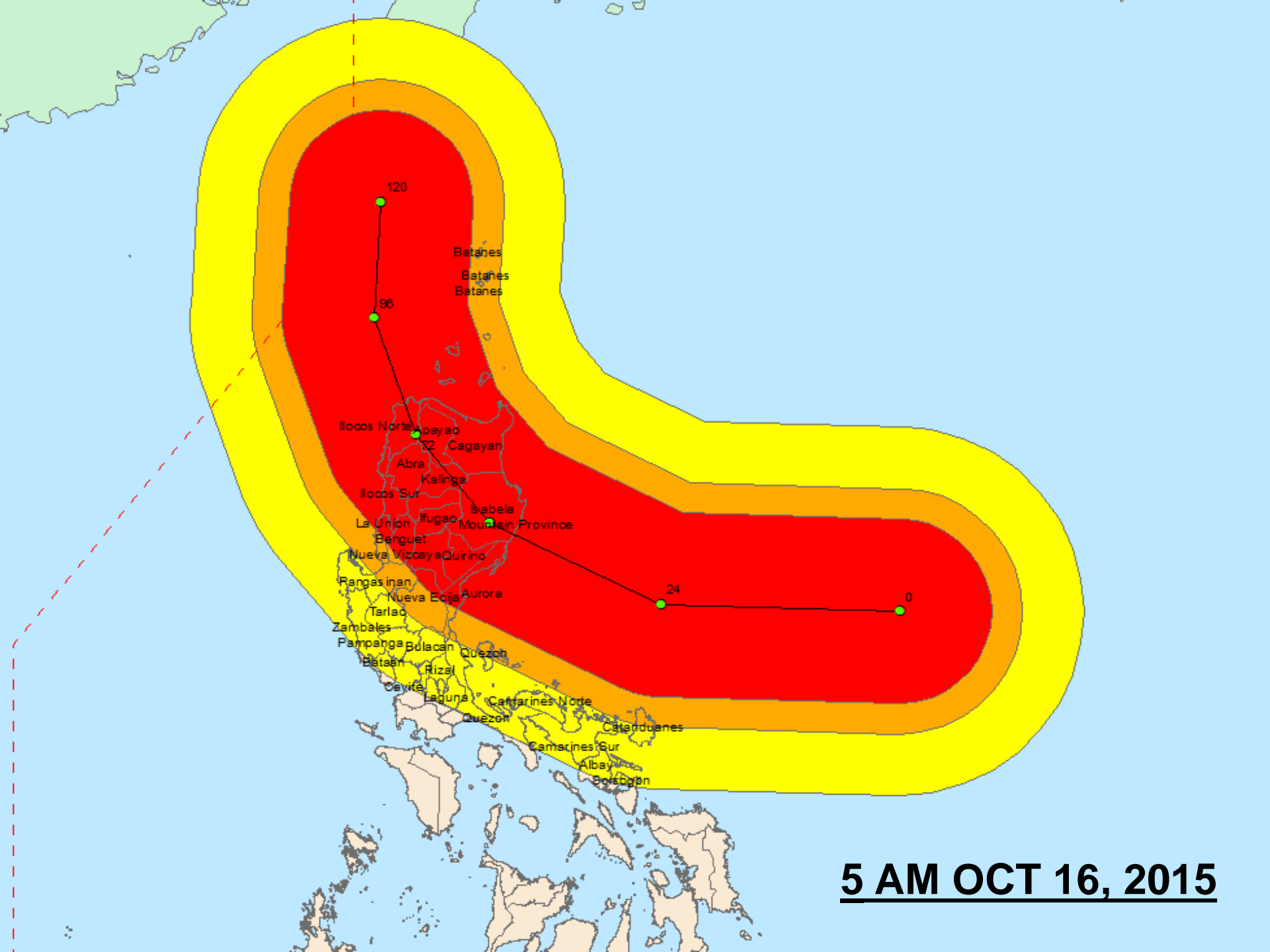
OCT 15, 2015

# OTHER PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

## REGION I

- Issued “No Fishing, Sailing, Boating Policy” in the municipalities of Lingayen and Agno, Pangasinan

# OTHER PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

## REGION II

- LGUs within coastal and seaboard have already issued “No Sailing Policy”
- Continuous monitoring of overflow bridges and water level of Magat Dam and other major water tributaries in the region

# OTHER PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

## REGION III

- Warned low lying areas for possible flashfloods and storm surge on coastal areas
- Advised tourists, through the Baler Municipal Tourism Office, to cancel their visits to Baler until weather permits
- Issuance of directives re: no outdoor activities along the beaches of Baler, Aurora and other coastal municipalities starting 5:00pm 16 Oct
- Prohibitions of fishermen sailing and passenger boats
- Continuous monitoring of Angat/Ipo and Bustos Dam
- Advised municipalities along the Pampanga river to monitor water level rise

# OTHER PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

## REGION IVA

- Sea Travel for both passenger and cargo vessel from and to island municipalities are not allowed as per coordination with PCG since the area is under PSWS No. 1
- Punong Barangays were also advised not to allow sea travel of small fishing vessels
