I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tropical Storm with International Name "KOPPU" has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility and was named "LANDO".

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 PM)	1410 km East of Baler, Aurora
Coordinates:	15.9°N, 134.7°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph.
Movement:	Forecasted to move West at 22 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tomorrow afternoon: 895 km East of Casiguran, Aurora Friday afternoon: 500 km East of Casiguran, Aurora Saturday afternoon: 320 km East of Tuguegarao City Sunday afternoon: 125 km East of Tuguegarao City Monday afternoon: 45 km North of Tuguegarao City or in the vicinity of Gattaran, Cagayan.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 500 km diameter of the tropical storm.
- Fisher folk are advised not to venture out over seaboard of Northern Luzon and over the eastern seaboard of Central Luzon.
- The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRMC Operations Center** disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 re Tropical Storm "LANDO"** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
