I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"NONA" has weakened into a Low Pressure Area.

Location of Center (as of 8:00 a.m.)	75 km West of SBMA, Olongapo City, Zambales
Coordinates:	14.8°N, 119.6°E

- All Public Storm Warning Signals (PSWS) are now lifted. However, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) is expected to bring light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms over Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon.
- Fisher folk are still advised not to venture out over the seaboard of northern, western and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- With this development and unless re-intensification occurs, this is the final weather bulletin for this weather disturbance.
