I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- **CARINA CONTINUES TO TRAVERSE THE BALINTANG CHANNEL.**
- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 500 km diameter of the Severe Tropical Storm.
- Fisher folk are alerted against rough to very rough seas over the Northern Eastern and Southern seaboard of Luzon.
- Areas under TCWS # 1 and #2, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA and the rest of Central Luzon are alerted against moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flash floods and landslides.
- At **1:00 AM** today, the center of severe tropical Storm "CARINA" was estimated based on all available data at **90km North Northeast of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (19.0°N, 120.6°E).**
- **STS** "CARINA" has maximum sustained winds of up to **100kph** near the center and gustiness of up to **130kph**.
- Forecast to move **Northwest at 20kph.**
- The Typhoon is expected to be at **550 km West of Itbayat, Batanes** (Outside PAR) by tomorrow evening. By Tuesday evening, it is expected to be at **1,155 km West of Itbayat, Batanes** (Outside PAR).

- The public and disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next weather bulletin to be issued at **5AM today**.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 21 for Tropical Storm "CARINA"** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
