At 4:00 pm today, a Low Pressure Area was estimated based on all available data at **205 km North of Itbayat, Batanes** (**22.6°N, 121.5°E**). This weather system is continuously enhancing the Southwest Monsoon (Habagat). Today (**Aug 12**), the provinces of Zambales, Bataan, Pangasinan, Cavite, Batangas, Mindoro and Palawan will experience monsoon rains which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. Metro MAnila, Western Visayas and the rest of Luzon will have Cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms. The rest of the country will have generally fair weather apart from isolated rainshowers of thunderstorms. This weather scenario is likely to persist until tomorrow (**Aug 13**).

By Sunday (**Aug 14**), Monsoon rains will still be experienced over the regions of Bicol, calabarzon, mimaropa and the provinces of Zambales, Bataan while Metro Manila may experience moderate to occasionally heavy rains. Visayas and the rest of Luzon will have Cloudy skies light to moderate rains and thunderstorms. Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms will prevail over Mindanao.

By Monday until Tuesday, (**Aug 15-16**), Southwest Monsoon will continue to bring Monsoon rains which may trigger flashfloods and landslides over Metro Manila and the regions of mimaropa, calabarzon and Bicol. Visayas, CARAGA and The rest of Luzon will be Cloudy with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms. The rest of Mindanao will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

By Wednesday until the rest of the outlook period (**Aug 17-19**) , Moderate to heavy rains will be experienced over Metro MAnila, calabarzon and the provinces of zambales, bataan, mindoro and palawan. Cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms is still expected over the rest of Luzon and Western Visayas. The rest of the country will have generally fair weather with chances of isolated rainshowers of thunderstorms.

This weather outlook will be updated as soon as significant changes in weather pattern occur.
