

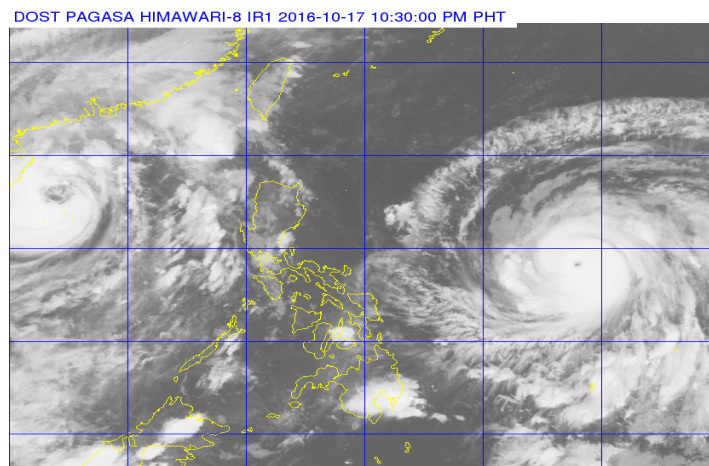
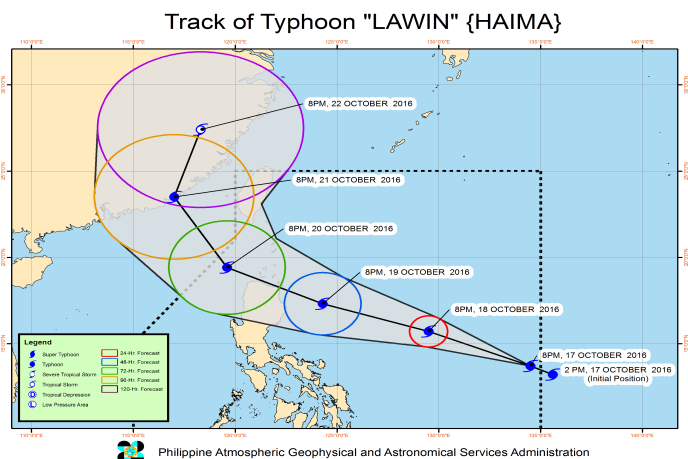

SEVERE WEATHER BULLETIN #2
TROPICAL CYCLONE ALERT: TYPHOON "LAWIN" [HAIMA]
Issued at 11:00 p.m., 17 October 2016

Typhoon "LAWIN" has maintained its strength as it continues to move in a west northwest direction.

- o Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 600 km diameter of the Typhoon.
- o Expected to intensify further before making landfall.
- o Expected to make landfall over Cagayan Area by Thursday morning (Oct. 20) then cross Ilocos Norte and Apayao.
- o Possible exit PAR on Friday morning (Oct. 21).

Location of Eye/Center: (as of 10:00 p.m.)	1,070 km East of Virac, Catanduanes
Coordinates:	13.9°N, 134.1°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 175 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 215 kph
