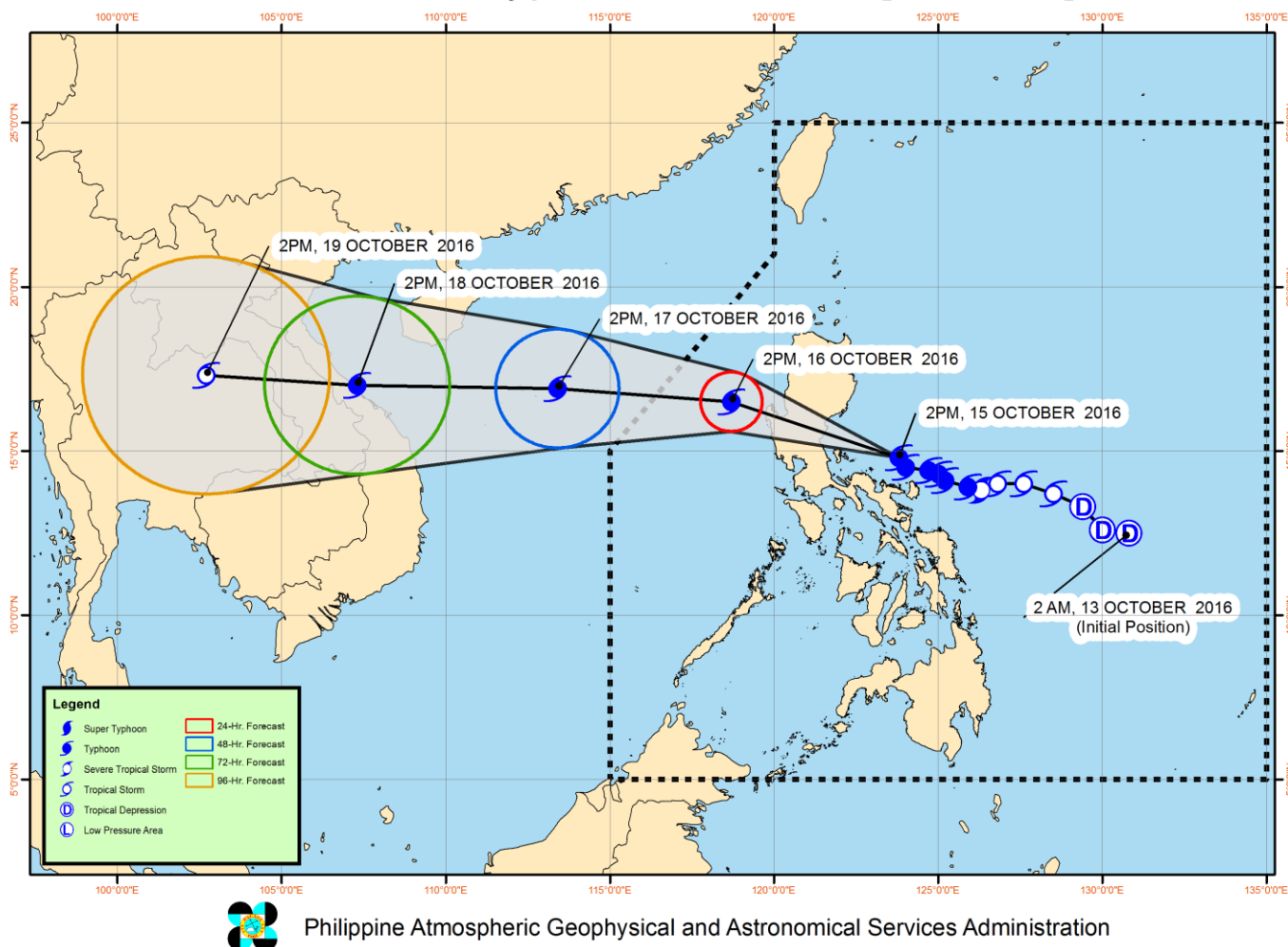

# Weather Update

## Track of Typhoon "KAREN" [SARIKA]



As of 4PM today, the eye of Typhoon "KAREN" (international name SARIKA) was located based on all available data at 205 km East of Infanta, Quezon (15.0°N, 123.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 180 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 22 kph.

"KAREN" has accelerated further and pose serious threat over Aurora Province. It is expected to make landfall over Aurora Province tomorrow early morning.

- As reported, there are 1,045 stranded passengers in Albay (621), Sorsogon (343), Catanduanes (20), and Masbate (61).
- Per report from MSWDO of Irosin, a pre-emptive evacuation was conducted. Five (5) families or fourteen (14) persons from Brgy. Mapaso (located at the foot of Mt. Bulusan) were evacuated for possible lahar flow in case of heavy rains.
