### **HIGHLIGHTS OF DISASTER RESPONSE ACTIONS**

1. Activation of the Disaster Response Clusters on 251500H Dec 2016 at NDRRMC, Camp Aguinaldo, QC
2. Convened the cluster members for a briefing on their respective emergency response preparedness and actions
3. Continuous Monitoring of the effects of TY Nina in coordination with RDRRMC member agencies of Regions 8, 5, CaLaBaRZon, MiMaRoPa, NCR, on developments and possible need for disaster response action

### FOOD AND NON-FOOD ITEMS CLUSTER

#### Number of Affected Families / Persons

There are **22,676 families** or **95,774 persons** affected in **291 barangays** in **Regions MIMAROPA, V and VIII**

A total of **16,106 passengers** remain stranded in **15 seaports**: **2 in CALABARZON**, **3 in MIMAROPA**, **11 in Region V**, and **4 in Region VIII**.

#### Status of Prepositioned Resources: Stockpile and Standby Funds

The Central Office (CO), Field Offices (FOs) and National Resource Operations Center (NROC) have a total stockpile and standby funds amounting to **₱660,455,265.58** with breakdown as follows:

##### a. Standby Funds

There is a total of **₱94,860,209.81** standby funds at the CO and FOs. Of the said amount, **₱71,237,102.65** is the available Quick Response Fund at the CO.

##### b. Stockpiles

There is also a total of **335,161** Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to **₱118,662,881.67** and available Food and Non-Food Items (FNFI) amounting to **₱446,932,174.10**.

#### Assistance Provided

##### DSWD

To date, a total of **₱7,112,134** worth of relief assistance has been provided to the affected families. Of the said amount, the Department provided **₱6,249,254.00** while the LGUs provided a total of **₱862,880**.

### CAMP COORDINATION AND CAMP MANAGEMENT

#### Evacuation

Evacuation was done in **Regions V and VIII**. A total of **4,614 families** or **18,382 persons** have pre-emptively evacuated. Of which, **3,518 families** or **13,984 persons** are currently staying in **65 evacuation centers** while **250 persons** or **1,014 families** chose to stay with relatives or friends.
