HIGHLIGHTS OF DISASTER RESPONSE ACTIONS

1. Activation of the Disaster Response Clusters on 251500H Dec 2016 at NDRRMC, Camp Aguinaldo, QC
2. Convened the cluster members for a briefing on their respective emergency response preparedness and actions
3. Continuous Monitoring of the effects of TY Nina in coordination with RDRRMC member agencies of Regions 8, 5, CaLaBaRZon, MiMaRoPa, NCR, on developments and possible need for disaster response action

FOOD AND NON-FOOD ITEMS CLUSTER

Status of Prepositioned Resources: Stockpile and Standby Funds

The Central Office (CO), Field Offices (FOs) and National Resource Operations Center (NROC) have a total stockpile and standby funds amounting to **₱660,455,265.58** with breakdown as follows:

a. Standby Funds

There is a total of **₱94,860,209.81** standby funds at the CO and FOs. Of the said amount, **₱71,237,102.65** is the available Quick Response Fund at the CO.

b. Stockpiles

There is also a total of **335,161** Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to **₱118,662,881.67** and available Food and Non-Food Items (FNFI) amounting to **₱446,932,174.10**.

Assistance Provided

DSWD

- a. Augmented 60,000 pouches of Ready to Eat Chicken Arrozcaldo to Field Office 5 intended for strandedees at ports and terminals.
- b. In transit delivery of 50, 000 Family Food Packs for additional augmentation to Field Office 5
- c. Transported thru C130 the 1,485 Family Food Packs for Virac Catanduanes
- d. Schedule airlifting of two (2) 1,500 Family Food Packs thru C130 on 27 December at 4:30AM and 5:30AM respectively in **Virac Catanduanes**.
- e. To date, a total of **₱7,112,134.00** worth of relief assistance has been provided to the affected families. Of the said amount, the Department provided **₱6,249,254.00** while the LGUs provided a total of **₱862,880.00**

LOGISTICS CLUSTER

Four (4) C130 planes to transport food and non food items from Mactan, Cebu to Virac, Catanduanes Airport.

On going clearing operation in Regions CAR, IV-A, V and VIII by DPWH

Installed barricades and warning signs (Road closure for safety reasons)

CAMP COORDINATION AND CAMP MANAGEMENT AND IDP PROTECTION

Number of Affected Families / Persons

There are **27,085 families** or **116,154 persons** affected in **395 barangays** in **Regions V, VIII CALABARZON and MIMAROPA**

A total of **16,155 passengers** remain stranded in **20 seaports: 2 in CALABARZON, 3 in MIMAROPA, 11 in Region V, and 4 in Region VIII.**

Evacuation

Evacuation was done in **Regions CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V and VIII.** A total of **26,811 families** or **114,933 persons** have pre-emptively evacuated. Of which, **22,078 families** or **93,271 persons** are currently staying in **367 evacuation centres** while **1,206 persons** or **5,243 families** chose to stay with relatives or friends.

DOH

- Php26,359,242.98 worth of logistics are prepositioned in regions III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VIII and NCR, while
- Php 41,921,211,46 are prepositioned at the DOH Central Office

PRC

- The Philippine Red Cross (PRC) staff, volunteers and logistics on standby and closely monitoring the effect of Typhoon Nina for rescue and relief operations

AFP Health Service

- Standby medical teams (with ambulances) ready for mobilization

International Partners

- The World Health Organization and United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) expressed support in the provision of health logistics (hygiene kits)

- Deploy Search and Rescue (SAR) assets and Search, Rescue, and Retrieval (SRR) teams with medical personnel in high risk areas based on geo hazard maps.
- Provide WCPC Desk and ensure the security of evacuation centers and assistance during the relief operations

GENERAL COORDINATION

- Activities of the Response Clusters are being coordinated by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Operations Division and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD).
- Coordination meetings are held at the NDRRMC conference room
- Cluster Leads are required to detail a senior officer in the NDRMMC OpCen to render a 24/7 basis duty.
