1. Activation of the Disaster Response Clusters on 251500H Dec 2016 at NDRRMC, Camp Aguinaldo, QC
2. Convened the cluster members on their respective emergency response preparedness and actions
3. Continuous Monitoring of the effects of TY Nina in coordination with RDRRMC member agencies of Regions 8, 5, CaLaBaRZon, MiMaRoPa, NCR, on the developments of their disaster response action

### FOOD AND NON-FOOD ITEMS CLUSTER

#### DSWD

1. A total of **335,161** Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to **₱118,662,881.67** and available Food and Non-Food Items (FNFI) amounting to **₱446,932,174.10**.
2. Augmented 60,000 pouches of Ready to Eat Chicken Arrozcaldo to Field Office V intended for strandeds at ports and terminals.
3. 50,000 Family Food Packs for additional augmentation to Field Office V
4. Transported thru C130 the 1,485 Family Food Packs for Virac Catanduanes
5. Schedule airlifting of two (2) 1,500 Family Food Packs thru C130 on 27 December at 4:30AM and 5:30AM respectively in Virac Catanduanes.
6. To date, a total of **₱7,112,134.00** worth of relief assistance has been provided to the affected families. Of the said amount, the Department provided **₱6,249,254.00** while the LGUs provided a total of **₱862,880.00**

### LOGISTICS CLUSTER

#### OCD

Four (4) C130 planes to transport food and non-food items from Mactan, Cebu to Virac, Catanduanes Airport. On 26 December 2016 only 1 C130 transported the 1,485 FFPs to Catanduanes. On December 27, 2016, 4:30 and another on 5:30 AM flight from Cebu to Virac will transport 3,000 FFPs @ 1,500 each plane.

Sixteen (16) road sections are closed to traffic; two (2) in Region II, three (3) in Region IV-B, Ten (10) in Region V and one (1) in Region VIII due to fallen trees and utility posts, on-going slope protection project (under contract), possible re-occurrence of landslides and high water elevation.

Six (6) road sections affected by previous typhoons and continuous monsoon rains are still closed to traffic; four (4) in CAR due to rock collapse, washed out embankment at abutments and slides and two (2) in Region IV-A due to landslide and rockfall, collapsed slope protection and vertical settlement of road and collapsed bridge.

- ❖ Various DPWH District Engineering Office Personnel are extending help/assistance to Local Government Units (LGU) for clearing operations in Typhoon affected areas.

### CAMP COORDINATION AND CAMP MANAGEMENT AND IDP PROTECTION

Evacuation was done in **Regions CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V and VIII**. A total of **26,811 families** or **114,933 persons** have pre-emptively evacuated. Of which, **23,284 families** or **98,514 persons** are currently staying in **367 evacuation centres** while **1,206 persons** or **5,243 families** chose to stay with relatives or friends.
