I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "JOLINA" has slightly intensified as it continues to move West Northwestward.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Expected to further intensify before making landfall over Northern Luzon between Friday evening or Saturday early morning.
- Possible raising of Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) No. 1 over Ilocos provinces, La Union, Abra, and Benguet tomorrow early morning,
- Meanwhile, moderate to occasionally heavy rains is expected over the Bicol region tonight and over most parts of Luzon beginning tomorrow. Residents in these areas are advised to be alert against possible flashfloods and landslides
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture over the easter seaboards of Luzon due to the approaching Tropical Depression.

Location of eye/center	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "JOLINA" was estimated based on all available data at 430 km East Southeast of Casiguran, Aurora (15.4°N, 126.0°E).
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West Northwest at 17 kph

ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Advisory No. **02** for **Tropical Depression “JOLINA”** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded in the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast
