Situation Overview

On 22 December 2017, the monitored Low Pressure Area east of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur has developed into a Severe Tropical Storm and was named “Vinta” (international name: Tembin). It exited Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on 22 December 2017.

Status of Affected Families / Persons

117,528 families or **550,805 persons** are affected in **1,019 barangays** in **Regions MIMAROPA, VII, IX, X, XI, XII, ARMM and CARAGA** (see Table 1; details in Annex A).

Camp Coordination and Camp Management IDP Protection

DSWD

A total of **19,203 families** or **89,524 persons** are currently staying inside **231 evacuation centers** in **Regions MIMAROPA, IX, X, XI, and ARMM** (see Table 2; details in Annex B).

Needs:

- Provision of relief assistance to families affected by TS VINTA who are currently staying inside evacuation centers as well as those staying with their families/friends.
- Provision of assistance to Marawi IDPs affected by TS Vinta.

Responses:

- DSWD Field Office XI provided 3,200 family food packs while the CSSDO provided hot meals through community kitchen.
- DSWD Field Office Caraga will provide pabaon package to all affected families in the municipality of Loreto, Veruela, Agusan del Sur returning to their respective houses
- 24/7 monitoring of the status of IDPs inside evacuation centers and tents thru the LDRRMOs and Camp Managers

For Marawi IDPs affected by TS Vinta, the following response actions have been taken:

- Provided relief assistance to 815 affected families in Baloi
- Distributed mats and malong to the affected families Baloi and Pantao Ragat
- 24/7 monitoring of the status of IDPs inside evacuation centers and tents thru the LDRRMOs and Camp Managers



Food and Non-Food Items

DSWD

Needs:

- Augmentation support to affected Regions from DSWD Central Office in the form of Food and Non-food Items.
- To replace thirty (30) tents used by Marawi IDPs in Lanao del Norte and Sur damaged by TS Vinta.

Responses:

- Continuous provision of family food packs by DSWD FO X to affected LGUs.
- DSWD CO augmented DSWD-FO X with RTE Chicken Arrocaldo (14,300), RTE Brown Rice Bar (3,500), Infant Cereal (1,000), Laminated Sack (100), Collapsible Water Container (2,000), Plastic Mats (687), Mosquito Nets (2,000) and Blanket (Used:2,335 and New: 146). This was transported thru C130 from Villamor Airbase to Laguindingan Airport and arrived at 10AM 25, December 2017.
- DSWD CARAGA to augment DSWD X with 10,000 FFPs.
- Non-food items like malong, mats, and laminated sacks were provided to internally displaced persons of Marawi Siege currently staying in Lanao del Norte.
- DSWD-FO CARAGA extended 500 Family Food Packs amounting to Php 141,900.00 to the affected families in Surigao City.

Gaps

- DSWD CO to procure tents replacing damaged tents of the Marawi IDPs..



Health

Needs:

- Emergency operations in affected areas to provide quad cluster response which includes medical / public health, water, sanitation and hygiene, nutrition, and mental health and psychosocial services.

Responses:

DOH CENTRAL OFFICE:

- Continuous monitoring of the situation
- Continuous coordination with NDRRMC member agencies on the latest update on the situation
- Deployed HEMB representatives to participate in Response Cluster Meeting at the NDRRMC Building, Camp Aguinaldo, Quezon City

DOH RO XI:

- Deployed 5 Human Resources for Health (HRH) teams to Talomo North District, Marilog District, Bunangin District and District A to provide health consultations and treatments.
- Human resources from RO VII and DOH Central Office provided technical assistance on WASH and Nutrition Services. DOH- Continuous coordination with DOH HRH teams, OCD and CHO for the provision of health quad-cluster services (public health/medical, nutrition, WASH and MHPSS)
- DOH RO XI provided assorted Drugs and Medicines, First Aid Kits and other supplies to all PDOHOs and Davao City Health Office
- Conducted RHA in Evacuation Sites in Davao City
- Continuously monitoring TS Vinta

DOH RO X:

- Logistical Support and Inventory Done
- Coordination with the PDRRMC and MDRRMC regarding the Search, Rescue and Retrieval Operations of the affected LGUs
- Started Leptospirosis prophylaxis to exposed individuals
- Mobilization of Health Personnel and HRH assigned in all ECs in Pantar, Pantao Ragat and Balo-I
- Conducted Rapid Health Assessment to the areas affected by TS Vinta
- Coordinated with NEOC and other partner agencies for the provision of water supply in Balo-I, Pantar and Pantao Ragat
- Health teaching regarding the use of aquatabs

DOH CARAGA:

- Standby Medical and Rapid Health Assessment Team (2 teams composed of 6 personnel each team)
- Operation Center on 24/7 duty
- Closely monitoring regarding the needed logistics of the affected regions
- Closely coordinating with the DOH Regional Offices and Provincial Offices regarding the monitored event
- Continuously validating, verifying and confirming the lists of casualties (deaths and injured) to the affected regions

Philippine Coast Guard

- Deployed standby medical team at their District Office in Palawan, Cagayan de Oro, Southwestern Mindanao and Southeastern Mindanao.



OCD

Needs:

- Transportation for the delivery of Food and Non-Food Items and transport of personnel from different clusters to affected regions/areas
- Road and Debris Clearing operations in all affected areas

Responses:

- Facilitated airlift of 1,600 family food packs from Manila to Kabacan thru PAL via Davao City and ferried by DPWH truck going to Kabacan.
- Facilitated airlift transport of relief goods from DSWD-NROC to Laguindingan Airport, Cagayan De Oro, Region 10
- Continuous monitoring of road situation
- LTFRB committed to provide transportation assistance for the delivery of services to affected areas.

DPWH

 - Closed to traffic due to washed-out bridge
 - Installed warning signs.
